Dear Parents/Carers,

Y6 Activity Week : Monday 5th – Friday 9th July

As you are already aware, we have booked Year 6 in at Liverpool Watersports Centre on Thursday 8th July. We can now let you know that this will form part of an activity week and we have details of some of the other events below along with the overall cost:

Monday 5th July – Military School Education (MSE) activity day. Four members of MSE staff will come in to offer a full day of activities including bush craft and forestry skills, shelter building, a campfire (with hot dogs and toasted marshmallows!), archery, soccer darts and team building activities. They will also bring a large bell tent which will be our HQ for the day.

Tuesday 6th July – Year 6 football tournament. All children will be put into teams and play in a Euros-style tournament. Each child will receive an engraved medal as a souvenir of the day. The Chip'd van (currently residing in The Ship car park on Hoylake High Street) will be on site to serve lunch.

Thursday 8th July – Liverpool Watersports Centre. Supervised activities include canoeing, swan pedal boats and paddle boarding.

Wednesday 7th and Friday 9th July – One of these days will be Sports Day and we will ensure the other day is filled with fun activities!

We know the children are missing out on the usual residential trip and hope that this week goes some way to making up for that, creating happy and lasting memories. We are confident the children will enjoy all the activities on offer.

The total cost for the week is £44. This is a voluntary contribution which can be paid via ParentPay. **We rely on parental contribution to fund the activities which will otherwise have to be cancelled.**

Another date for your diary is **Tuesday 13th July**. We have arranged for Deacon John (from St. Catherine's parish) to join us for a **Leavers' Service at 2:30pm**. We are hoping that this will take place outside and would love to be able to invite all parents and carers to celebrate with us but this is obviously subject to COVID restrictions. We will be in touch nearer the time.

The children's last day of school is Thursday 15th July and we will end in the same way as last year – ice lollies outside followed by a giant water fight in the afternoon! The children will need to bring in their own water pistol on this day.
