

Children are provided with a choice of non - sugary drinks and fresh drinking water is available at all times.

Behaviour

Windmills recognises the importance of positive and effective behaviour management strategies in promoting children 's welfare, learning and enjoyment.

We aim to develop in the children a sense of care and consideration for one another.

We believe that it is the right of all children to be safe and happy. Any negative behaviour will be dealt with in a calm but assertive manner. Staff discuss alternative courses of action with the children, enabling them to behave more positively in the future. Staff are clear and open in stating and explaining non – negotiable issues.
