When the junior child was not on the bus one day, the infant child really missed her and his Mum discovered what a powerful kindness this has been. And all of it happening without the knowledge of any of the adults in their lives!

#### **Emails**

The school is unique in allowing parents to have direct access to the teachers through email communication. We know that this enhanced communication between home and school helps us to provide the very best education for your children. We have been asking our instrumentalists to play in class music lessons and it has been wonderful to hear the children playing together.

Help us take this learning even deeper - encourage your children to talk about what they have been learning in music - they may be able to tell you something new about a composer or style. Make the most of opportunities to listen to different kinds of music with your children, have them tell us about the music they discover.

Our whole school RE focus, 'Who is my Neighbour?' is enriched by songs like 'Penny Lane', learnt alongside the liturgical songs which are always at the heart of our community. Each week, the children sing and play hymns reflecting our place in the Liturgical calendar - the singing at this week's Ash Wednesday service was a beautiful start to Lent. The children are now focused daily on performing specific acts of kindness as a Lenten offering.
